D.BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

The National Aviation University is one of the most powerful aviation higher educational institutions in the world with about 25 thousand students, among whom there are more than 1300 foreign students from 49 countries. The University history dated back to 1933.

Retaining the leading position in preparing specialists for aviation industry the National Aviation University turned into classical one, providing high quality education in Economics, Law, Logistics, Architecture and Design, Psychology, etc. There are 3 institutes, 9 faculties function at the University. The University has a training aerodrome, unique hangar, radio equipment and aviation ground equipment facilities, aerodynamic training complex with the wind tunnel, State Museum of Aviation. The University successfully collaborates with the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO). Two ICAO European Regional Training Centres are functioning for aviation personnel upgrading.

Improving the strategy of internationalization is the aim of National Aviation University. One of the best ways to realize the strategy is through integration of its research and academic activity into the global educational space. The National Aviation University holds approximately 160 cooperation agreements with the institutions around the world, joint research activities, organization of international practical and scientific conferences, seminars, forums, symposia, etc. NAU develops wholesome cooperation with many European partners what has positive influence on the international and educational activity.
